









<p>1. Make dots of various sizes using a flat tool. Check for paint consistency.</p> 	<p>2. Make a center dot and put 8 dots around using the 4 point anchor system like this.</p> 	<p>3. Make a center dot and put 8 dots around using the 4 point anchor system as small as you can!</p> 
<p>4. Make a center dot with 8 dots in the first row. Now add 8 larger dots nestled in between. (Finish mine and then do your own.)</p> 	<p>5. Use a flat end tool to make a straight line of small dots. Dip between each dot.</p> 	<p>6. Use a round end tool to make a straight line of small dots. (They should all be the same size.) Dip between each dot.</p> 
<p>7. Use a round end tool to walk the dots in a straight line. Dip only ONCE! How many nice dots can you get? Check for paint consistency for best results!</p> 	<p>8. Use a round end tool to walk the dots half way around these dots. Dip only ONCE per side! Dip a second time and do the other side.</p> 	<p>9. Use a round end tool to make small dots that are the SAME SIZE around another dot. Dip between each dot. (This is just outlining the dot.)</p> 
<p>10. Nestle a larger dot in between each dot to make a 3rd row.</p> 	<p>11. Walk the dots around the 4 large dots in this design. Walk the dots around those dots to make a second layer.</p> 	<p>12. Put top dots on these dots. (Aim for 1/2 smaller. Then go slightly smaller than you think it should be.)</p>
